

# Fire and Emergency Training Course

Fires can cause serious injury or death and can also destroy your workplace, your most cherished possessions and home. In Australia each year, some 70 people die as a result of fire, and probably more than 1000 people suffer from serious burns.

Clause 17 of the Occupational Health and Safety Regulation 2001 states that an employer must ensure that, in the event of an emergency at any place of work at which the employer's undertaking is conducted, arrangements have been made for;

- the safe and rapid evacuation of persons from the place of work, and
- emergency communications, and
- appropriate medical treatment of injured persons.

With proper use, a portable fire extinguisher will be able to reduce or eliminate the degree of injury, damage and cost to business in the event of a small fire. You can further reduce the risk of fire occurring in your workplace and ensure your workplace and employees are safe by undertaking the Fire and Emergency Training provided by a trained Fire Fighter.

This training course provides valuable information on all aspects of fire prevention, management and safety as well as the practical use of extinguishers and other fire safety methods. Participants will learn about;
